With this Addenda, we are providing the following information and updates:

- **As of May 7, the Tribe has still not received a Construction Access Agreement from the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW-Landowner) for construction access via Shannon Road.**
- **Once WDFW provides the Tribe with a Construction Access Agreement and it is reviewed internally, we will email the Construction Access Agreement to attendees at the mandatory job walk, and we will select and publish an updated proposal/bid due date with that forthcoming Addendum.**
- **Despite the repeated delays, the Tribe still anticipates receiving bids, selecting a construction contractor, and removing WDFW’s derelict fish passage barrier during this summer’s in-water work window. We thank you again for your patience.**
